

LEGAL GROUNDS FOR THE VACCINATION AND IMMUNIZATION POLICY

Based on the Act of 5 December 2008 on *Preventing and fighting off human infections and infectious diseases*, article 6, paragraph 1, subparagraph 4 (consolidated text, Journal of Laws of 2013, item 947), the Regulation of the Minister of Science and Higher Education of 5 July 2007 on *Health and Safety at Universities* (Journal of Laws no 128, item 897), article 11, paragraph 4, the Regulation of the Minister of Health of 18 August 2011 on *Obligatory Immunization* (Journal of Laws no 182, item 1086), the Regulation of the Minister of Health of February 2, 2006 on *Sanitary-epidemiological analysis* (Journal of Laws no 25, item 191), as well as based on the Resolution of the Rector of the Medical University of Silesia in Katowice of January 13, 2010 on *Terms and procedures for obligatory medical examinations and vaccination for candidates and medical students of the Medical University of Silesia in Katowice*, each candidate must be examined by a physician who fills out a health assessment form. The physician certifies an immune status of the candidate with a stamp and signature.

Every candidate is obliged to submit a health assessment file including the following results which must be certified by a physician:

- Medical examination;
- Hepatitis B Hbs Ag/Hbs Ab.
